From the Pastor's Desk

Getting to Know Jesus. In the musical, “The King and I,” there is the famous song, *Getting to Know You*. The song sings of the process of getting to know someone; in this case, the children of the King of Siam getting to know their new teacher from England and her getting to know them. The lyrics recognize that this is not a matter of introductions, but one that takes time; it is a process. The same is true of our “getting to know” Jesus.

We have all been introduced to Jesus as a child. We learned about Him and His Church in religion class.

The difficulty is that all too often we remain on that very basic level of introduction when it comes to getting to know Jesus, the Holy Spirit – God. Stories, like the one today that centers around a wedding feast, are tools for us to get to know Jesus in a deeper fashion. The appearance of the star, the arrival of the Magi from different nations point to Jesus’ mission to all of humanity. We see the Spirit descending like a dove and at His baptism and hear the voice from heaven at Jordan’s bank to give us further knowledge about Jesus; and now we see Him, God made visible, obeying His mother, a human being, and trusting in God, giving direction to the servants. In this, He shows us that ordinary attitudes of obedience and trust can make the ordinary (water) into something extraordinary – wine of the best vintage.



We come to know that Jesus comes not for a few and that as He is Light for the world, so too we are to be reflections of that light in our daily living. We know that as He washed the sins of our humanity away in the Jordan so we could emerge with Him and receive His Spirit and hear the words, “You are my Beloved in whom I am well pleased.”

Today we know that a reluctant Jesus, at first, trusts in God and honors His mother’s request. And such trust produces some very fine wine, gives glory to God and enables His disciples to believe more firmly in Him. We too are called to trust as Jesus shows us the way; that trusting in God’s grace and mercy, we can do anything. We can give forgiveness to those who have hurt us, we can assist those who you or I might find undesirable or unworthy and we can bring the extraordinary from the ordinary.

Today Jesus shows us He is here to change things; wine is but the beginning. In the end, He changes that wine into His very life blood and asks us to drink of the saving Cup. Jesus is more than just a tiny baby in a manger, He is more than just a wise man, and He is more than just a great prophet or philosopher. Jesus is more than the boundaries or descriptions we often place around Him. It is this “more” that we need to be open to and discover in our daily prayer. We cannot “get to know Jesus” unless we spend time with Him daily.


Mary knew Him, and so made the extraordinary request at the wedding feast. The disciples knew Him better because they spent time with Him and witnessed this, His first miracle. The guests knew that God was present in some particular way as they gloried God for the fine wine.

You and I can always know Jesus better. The way to do this is to spend some time with these stories that tell us about Jesus, who He really is for us. With this story and many others like it in the Scriptures, we can pray trusting in God’s power, being obedient to His will and bringing the extraordinary presence of God into the ordinary duties of our daily life.



QUINCEANERA PREPARATION CLASS

Young women planning to celebrate a Quinceanera are required to participate in a single-day formation program prior to the date of their celebration. In Hispanic culture, the Quinceanera is the next step to adulthood, after the Sacrament of Confirmation, during which, the Church tells us that the baptized "are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit." Since parents are role models for their children, it is assumed that before scheduling a Quinceanera, they, along with their daughter, are actively participating in Sunday Masses. Daughters who are preparing for their Quinceanera should have already received their Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation. If these Sacraments have not been received, arrangements must be made first for Sacramental preparation. This process usually takes at least a year. A Quinceanera preparation class will be held at St. John Bosco School (1231 171st Pl. Hammond) on **March 1st**, 10:00 AM-4:00 PM, facilitated by Adeline Torres. The cost is \$25 (which pays for materials, lunch, snacks). Please enter through Door A. THE WORD




(Readings for January 26, 2025, The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time)

- I. *Nehemiah 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10* Ezra the priest stood before the people and proclaimed the book of the law. Then he “interpreted it so that all could understand.” He declared the day holy and urged people to rejoice.




