From the Pastor's Desk

O happy fault! – O necessary sin of Adam! – That gave to us such a redeemer.

It sounds strange to us to exult the advantages of sin, to glory in our faulty human nature. Yet, this is precisely the point of Easter. Or better understood, this is exactly the point of Jesus' incarnation (becoming one like us in all things but sin) which finds its fulfillment in His passion, death and resurrection.

Sin is the crux, that is, the pivotal or essential point at issue that requires resolution. It is of some interest to note that the word *crux* comes from the Latin and means: cross (U). And so the crux of the issue regarding our salvation is overcome by the *Sacra Crux*, the Sacred Cross of Jesus, the Christ. Sin no longer rules at the center, the *crux*, but now it is the *Sacra Crux* that stands in the center of all time and eternity.

Now, some might find this talk of sin on Easter Sunday to be out-of-place. We would like to think that the essential point is New Life. To think of sin as the pivotal point on which swings the salvation of the world is a bit too messy for a day commemorated with new cloths, cute bunnies and colorful eggs. Yet, you and I cannot be fooled — for new cloths get dirty, the cute bunnies are the same rabbits that eat your flowers and those colored eggs can only be enjoyed when the colored shell is cracked.

No, we must keep our eyes fixed on what is the crux of the issue. For it was our selfish ways, yes, our ways that we inherited from our first parents, that made it necessary for God to come down here. But God did not come down here like an angry parent who threatens to stop the car if you and I don't behave. God came down, not as a parent, but as a brother. He was like you and me in everything, except one thing – He was not held hostage to the way of the first Adam, the way of disobedience. He cried, He felt pain in His heart and in His body, He got tired, He was hungry, and He enjoyed a good glass of wine with His friends (who were a most eclectic bunch).

He endured all of what we endure, happiness, love, betrayals, hurt and pain and yet, He was obedient to His Father. He stuck to His guns, or better, He stuck to His message, the good news of God's Will that all be holy and all be saved. For this, He was called a sinner, though He did not sin, and was killed by sinners who thought they were the chosen.

Easter confronts us with the reality, the real reality, that God's triumph is the only one that is eternal and final. The *Sacra Crux* has turned the tables on sin. This is all God's work; it needs no stimulus from us. We are initiated into this mystery in baptism and we proclaim it every Sunday in the Holy Eucharist. A mystery not to be solved but to be embraced; how death leads to life, how sacrifice blooms and Eternal Springtime, how in giving of ourselves we do indeed receive all we need. The fulfillment of the mystery of the *Sacra Crux* is in eternity, but you and I are called to live in it today, in 2024.

Growing Together: St. Michael's is poised to be a significant parish in the long future of this area. Many parishes unfortunately have closed or been merged in recent years, often because they did not keep up with the needs of the time. We do not want to be in that boat. Our goals to air condition the parish school and build a new accessible parish administrative center will help us to keep thriving and growing. Just like a family, everyone is needed to make this parish prosper. Just like a family, each individual decision affects the whole family for better or worse. We need the whole family to accomplish these needs. I understand that many might not really understand or know about what we need to do. That is why the people at the GIFT table are here each week, giving their time, to assist you in making an informed decision. Please visit the GIFT table by the elevator if you have any questions or concerns about the projects. Nearly 77% has been pledged by less than 40% of parishioners. We thank all of those who have pledged and encourage the many who have not yet made a pledge to please do so. We need our whole Parish family in order to make this happen.




