From the Pastor's Desk

Gifts that are to be used. Today we commemorate the Ascension of our Lord. At the Last Supper, Jesus promised that He would not abandon us but will send the gift of the Holy Spirit, the Advocate who is always with us.

It is the Advocate that leads us to live a life worthy of our call to be disciples of Jesus. Like the title implies, the Advocate, is on our side if you and I let Him work through us. He pleads our cause before God, He strengthens us to live as Christ has taught us, He purifies our deepest intentions so that you and I can give God service for all the right reasons.

During this week, spend some more time in prayer to prepare yourself for next Sunday when we commemorate the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost upon the disciples of Jesus. We received that same Spirit in Baptism which was, for most, confirmed in us at Confirmation. During this week, you and I are called on to prepare ourselves for the mission Jesus sends us out to accomplish. The gift of the Holy Spirit in us is not for our own personal gain or satisfaction, it is given to us to do God's work. What sort of work are you going to take up for God after Pentecost?



Jesus sends you and me out to do His work and gives us the Holy Spirit for wisdom and strength to do His works. There is a multitude of ways for you to spread the gifts of the Holy Spirit around. For instance, there are many homebound and infirmed who need the gifts you have, the gifts of compassion and care.

There are many ways to use the gifts of the Holy Spirit; by coming forward to tutor at a local school, by teaching the faith in our Faith Formation Program, or by working with couples preparing for the sacrament of Marriage with the Marriage Preparation team couples. Perhaps it might be to offer yourself to be a minister of Holy Communion at Mass, or a reader of God's Word, or a welcoming usher. If you are fairly new at retirement, there is wonderful opportunities to help the less fortunate in our Good Samaritans ministry. The Holy Spirit invites us to a fuller participation by singing and praying together at Mass and by our service to others.

Today's feast does not end Jesus' participation with us here on earth. Rather, it deepens His presence everywhere in all times by the gift of the Holy Spirit. So too for you and me, the coming celebration of the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost is not an end of the story but the beginning. What work or works does God intend for you to do strengthen by the gifts of the Holy Spirit you have received?

Red is the color of the day for Pentecost. Red reminds us of the color of the fire God puts in us to fuel us to do His works. **Wear something red on Pentecost Sunday**. Let your renewed commitment to the Holy Spirit be shown in the "wearing of the red" and in your willingness to serve others in Christ's name.

Mothers are God's gift of love. Mother's Day is a fairly recent holiday in our history. Though the marking of the day is recent the memories, it stirs are very venerable. The very word "mother" conjures up all sorts of feelings for all sorts of people. Many have had a fine relationship with their mothers. Sadly, some have not. On this happy day, we who rejoice in the love of our mothers should remember in our prayers those who did not enjoy or even know their mother.

Mothers know what it is to love and be loved and they can know the pain of separation from their children. Today I ask all the moms out there to exchange prayers with the troubled moms. By this holy exchange of prayer and Christian Concern, mothers will reflect our common mother, Mary. Mary who knew the pain of separation yet prayed for the needs of all of us and who let her son go so that we might live. For in the end, a mother's love cannot be restricted to her family alone. A mother's love is usually too big for one family and so it spills over into concern for others too. Mary was and is such a mother. Like Mary, may our mothers pray for us and for others as we pray for them. May they find in Mary a noble pattern of trust in God's will and openness to cooperate with God, as Mary did, to bring joy and life to the world.

Mark Your Calendars! Put an Alert on Your Smart Phone! On Sunday, June 2nd, we will celebrate the Feast of the Corpus Christi. It is a special day to show honor to our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament of His Body and Blood. A very traditional way of honoring a person is to have a parade. So that is what we are going to do after the 11:30 AM Mass. We call our parades "processions." We will process with the Blessed Sacrament outside the church through our cemetery, around Mount Calvary and back into the church. Along the route, we will have altars set up to pause for prayer and song and special blessings (Benedictions) given with the Blessed Sacrament. Our festive parade honors our Lord. FIRST COMMUNICANTS are especially invited to dress in the First Communion clothes to help lead the procession. All of our prayerful labors are rewarded in the end with a wonderful lunch provided for all the "pilgrims" who walked with Jesus. Whoever said, "religion isn't fun" has never been to one of these festive gatherings.


