From the Pastor's Desk

Some mysteries are to be appreciated. Over the ages, great thinkers have tried to explain the mystery we commemorate today, the Holy Trinity. All of these attempts are good, but none of them really explains the mystery of the Godhead. This mystery, and other mysteries of our faith, are not mysteries to be solved by a good detective like Sherlock Homes.

The mysteries of the faith are like works of great art. For example, the artist Monet would view a landscape and then transcribe it to canvas with the intention that his work would reveal more than just a picture but a vision filled with emotion, he struggled to present us with a mystery. Such a mystery is to be gazed on and appreciated. Understanding the details of the artist's technique never fully explains the art they produce. So it is with the mystery of God.

All of the words and images we use to understand who God is for us are, in the last analysis, "our" words about a God who is not like us. Trouble arises when we begin to think that our words can fully describe an indescribable God. We can become almost complacent in our vision of God. The mystery of the Trinity reminds us that though we have some understanding of how God has been revealed in our history as the

Father, Son, and Spirit, we have a long way to go to "know" fully


this wonderful God.

What we do know from the Trinity is that God is Love. The unity of the Godhead is Love, a love without boundaries. Being created in the image of this Love, we are called to love in the same way as the Trinity, to love without boundaries. In an age of people who tell us we need to build walls to be secure, we should be thankful God did not wall Himself off from us, His creation. Jesus, Son of the Father, bestows on us His Spirit so as He did, so we can and must do. Jesus did not build walls, rather He dismantled them. Literal walls are only manifestations of the walls we erect in our hearts and attitudes. The simple fact is that God did not make the world with walls; we did after the Fall. The fruit of our disobedience is isolation, the fruit of our conversion to God is to be obedient in the pattern of Jesus.

When you and I reflect upon on our daily lives reminding ourselves how boundless God's love has been for us, then we have found the necessary key that enables them to love more like God. Practicing this kind of love can only lead to perfection, can only lead to God. When we are able to love without boundaries, then we are taken up into the glorious unity of Love, our God.






