From the Pastor's Desk

Not an Ending -- A Beginning. Pentecost marks the beginning of the mission of the Church. It closes the Easter Season but pushes us forward into the shoes of the fisherman, Jesus. The mission that begins with the anointing of the Holy Spirit is much more than maintenance. We sometimes confuse the health of a parish by its financial assets. All too often parishes hang their hat on the amount that is in their savings account. Financial stability is a good thing; but it useless unless it serves the mission of the church to bring Christ into the world by bringing Christ into the lives of both the poor and needy and the lives of those who are well-off.

Our collective resources maintain our parish, but cannot stop there.

They need to finance the spread of the Good News of Jesus.

Our parish is our base of operations. We all need to take seriously our anointing with the Holy Spirit. You and I are anointed for a purpose, our parish is there to help, encourage and sometimes prod us to honor that purpose; to be the presence of Jesus to others, face to face and on Facebook. Our online presence needs to reflect our anointing too, otherwise a person can be like Dr. Jeckle and Mr. Hyde. Charity, above all else, is the hallmark of the Christian, even in online forums.

Living through the reality of our anointing does not take a special degree or technical knowledge. What it does take is our openness to the Spirit we have received. To be docile to the Holy Spirit who clarifies for us is what is most important. Now, the devil likes to muck that all up with suggestions like, “as long as you believe Jesus is in you, you don’t need to go to worship Him in Church” or the belief that “God understands” when we know we have not done what we ought to do. These justifications are manufactured by ourselves and not by God. Being docile to the Holy Spirit is having the courage to challenge these and other reasons that water down our faith in practice.


If we are open to the Holy Spirit in our daily life, we begin to reflect Jesus in our decisions. How do we use our time; is it mainly for my enjoyment or in service towards someone else? How we use our financial resources; is it primarily for my security and entertainment or shared with those who have not? How we pray; for my own needs or remembering over and above my own needs the needs of the destitute, the lonely, the prisoner, the forgotten sick? When the Holy Spirit fuels our decisions daily, our actual life changes.

You and I were not given the great gift of the Holy Spirit for us to put it away in our pocket for our personal satisfaction. The fire of the Holy Spirit should burn a hole in my pocket until I allow it to spill out of my very self towards others. The apostles did not remain in the upper room after the Spirit descended on them like tongues of fire. No, they went out immediately and began to speak of how Jesus changed their lives. Yet, they all knew they needed to stick together, to renew their fire each week at the Altar of the Lord. The excitement they have is not any different than how excitedly a person shares with a friend the great restaurant they discovered and then takes them there to share at the table. That cannot be reserved to such passing things, you and I must kindle that same zeal in our lives that boldly tell others (children, family and friends) that coming to Christ’s Table each week is the place where life is kindled for the real pleasures that last.

At the end of the 11:30 AM Mass, we will process with the Blessed Sacrament outside the church through our cemetery, around Mount Calvary and back into the church. Along the route, we will have altars set-up to pause for prayer and song and special blessings (Benedictions) given with the Blessed Sacrament. FIRST COMMUNICANTS are especially invited to dress in the First Communion clothes to help lead the procession. All of our prayerful labors are rewarded in the end with a wonderful lunch provided for all the “pilgrims” who walked with Jesus. Whoever said, “religion isn’t fun” has never been to one of these festive gatherings.







NEWS FROM THE SCHOLARSHIP COORDINATOR

Families at St. Michael will be able to lower their out-of-pocket school costs thanks to an expansion of the Choice Scholarship program passed by the Indiana State Legislature.

Prior restrictions on the Choice Scholarship pathway were removed and the income eligibility for a family of four raised to \$220,000. This should increase eligibility for a significant number of our parish families. For families that do now qualify, their out-of-pocket costs could be reduced for the next school year by over 70% of the full amount, leaving approximately \$2,000 or less for each child's tuition. 
