From the Pastor's Desk

What's so special about ordinary time? It is always a shock, so to speak, when we leave the festivity of Easter Time and the two feasts that follow, Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi. Entering the time for green vestments and altar cloths seems like such a downer. Yet, Ordinary Time is that time of our Church Year in which we learn to live the promise of Christ's birth and resurrection, and what this means to our daily life. How do we reflect the realities of these powerful celebrations in our day to day living of the Christian life? Ordinary does not mean unimportant, or boring or disposable; for if that is the case, probably 85% to 90% of our time on earth could be done away with. Yet, I would not want to lose the memories and lessons of my ordinary time and I'm certain you would not want to lose yours.

Much of what is written in the Gospels are ordinary events. The disciples learn about Jesus and their mission through ordinary means. Too many people to feed? Jesus tells them 'you feed them' and then He shows them: breaking the bread and distributing the fish. Peter's mother-in-law is sick. Jesus prays, the mother-in-law regains health and then cooks dinner for everyone. The disciples are caught in a storm on the lake. Jesus calms them down and then calms the waves. In these ordinary events, Jesus shows the extra-ordinary Presence of God.

God's presence is in the spectacular. Yet, often, God is given only some mention but generally His Presence is overshadowed by the spectacle. It is in the ordinary that God really chooses to work in my life and yours. So, coming to terms with the ordinariness of our lives is essential if we are to experience the extra-ordinary Presence of God in our daily workings.

Fr. Justin Duvall, a Benedictine monk and former Archabbot of St. Meinrad in southern Indiana, puts it well. Fr. Justin relates to us that St. Benedict understands the importance of this ordinariness well:

In the dynamics of living together, in the ordinary life of the monastery (or our homes); in the rhythm of prayer and work and reading (and relaxation) – that is where we find God revealing Himself to us. And it is where we seek God. We pursue God in the ordinary, and not exclusively in the highs and lows of life.

It's not that big celebratory events or great vacations in wonderful locations aren't places where we find God's Presence' it's that such high points are not the main reason for living. Rather, these are gifts to us just as every day is a gift. Some gifts have fancier wrapping and some are just given unwrapped. For God reveals His Presence everyday in a multitude of ways and through a variety of people and events.

You and I need to adjust our attitude. Fr. Justin offers us insight in this regard:


First, I think we have to simply acknowledge that it's part of our human nature to experience 'the routine' as stifling, and so we shouldn't be discouraged when it happens. It should simply be a reminder to us that, in the present state of the world, everything hasn't yet been perfected, but that doesn't keep God's love from operating in the ordinary moments of life.

To open ourselves to that other dimension of love from God we can do a number of things. We can spend some time in reflection. We can take some time out, step back and reflect on the circumstances of our lives. At the end of the day, we could simply take a few minutes and ask ourselves, "What have been the blessings of this day for me?" Perhaps we'll find that the people and events that didn't appear to be blessings at the time were, in fact, a pathway for God's grace.

We also need to practice cherishing and accepting the people whom God has put in our lives. St. Benedict tells us to "support with the greatest patience one another's weaknesses of body or behavior." We can begin by checking our own expectations of others. We can acknowledge that setting unrealistic expectations for others can lead to frustration and disappointment for ourselves.

Realizing and cherishing God's Presence in the ordinary times of our life takes some effort. But no good effort ever goes unrewarded. Perhaps that is why the liturgical season of Ordinary Time lasts longer than all the weeks of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter. Those celebratory times are great, but you and I need time to learn how to live the mysteries we celebrate. We need this time not to take a break from church but to, in a sense, unpack what we have been celebrating and so be more able to see and revel in God's Presence in the ordinary time of daily life.

"A LOOK BACK IN TIME"



On September 29, 1874, Bishop Dwenger solemnly blessed the new church building which was dedicated to St. Michael the Archangel. The first baptism, funeral and wedding in the new church were celebrated shortly thereafter. In 1875, a rectory was constructed and Rev. Gottfried Kueng was appointed the first pastor of St. Michael Parish, a position he would hold until 1876. Rev. John H. Bathe was appointed pastor in 1877 but remained at the parish for only five months. Rev. Francis Xavier Deimel was appointed pastor in 1877 and in 1878 bought two bells for the church and organized the first parish mission.
