


From the Pastor's Desk

Don't rock the boat! When I was younger I used to be up early on vacation begging my father to take me out in the boat. The trouble was I didn't catch much of anything whether at dawn or at dusk. So, I learned that fishing could be exciting but it was mainly a matter of being, being there in the boat or on the pier, just simply being there attentive to the red and white bobber but not obsessive about its movement.

One thing that always did put the fear of God into me was being out on the lake as a summer thunderstorm was brewing. The wind kicking up the placid water into choppy waves and trying to get back to the dock before the sky sent down its fury was more adrenalin producing than the tallest roller coaster. I can just imagine the fear of the disciples in that boat. Fear has a way of clouding out the hope that is present in a difficult situation. Jesus was that hope for them and He still is that hope for us in the stormy times of our lives.

I now realize that this was good training for life; both when the lake was calm and when an approaching storm made the waves very choppy. Life is very much like that time spent in the boat fishing. There is excitement, disappointment, a sense of freedom, yet a sense of being tethered to the fishing pole; a time to let the mind wonder yet being held down to earth by the waiting for the fish to bite.

Those storms could be personal and can be communal as well, as we strive to reach our



needed goal to update our school's air quality with air conditioning and to provide a safer and more accessible experience for parishioners and visitors to our parish office. Unfortunately, the tendency to see the glass half empty can encourage fear. We can become so fearful of our personal situation that it prevents us from hoping we can participate in the work that needs to be done. Our fear can paralyze us; fear I won't have enough, and fear that I can't contribute in a meaningful way, fear that what is needed is beyond our capability.

Fear would have sunk that tiny boat on that violent lake back in Galilee, but hope was quietly lying in the stern of the boat. When the disciples cried out in fear, they awakened hope. Hope was all they had, hope personified in Jesus. Their cry was for help and so should ours be. In seeking help, we profess our certain faith that God is the one who does all the good work in our hearts. God can help you and me be generous and not let our fears trump our better and generous spirits.

Don't be afraid to cry for help, because that shows you expect an answer and that is the practice of one's faith. Like the disciples on the lake, we recognize that we have hope in the boat with us; hope personified in Jesus Christ, who does not abandon us but looks for us to call upon Him and trust that He can calm our fears just as He did the waves.

"A LOOK BACK IN TIME"



Fr. Deimel died in 1881 and was replaced by Rev. William Berg (pictured to the left). The parish had 80 families. In 1886, Fr. Berg obtained the assistance of two Franciscan Sisters of the Sacred Heart to teach parish children during lunch hours at the local public school. The sisters lived in upstairs rooms of the Scherer home until the parish finished converting a barn into a convent.

Two additional rooms were later added and that structure continued as a convent until 1914. Religious education classes were taught on church grounds even as Schererville felt the devastating effects of diphtheria and the flu for several years.


The parish office will be closed until 11:00 AM so staff may participate in the pilgrimage.
