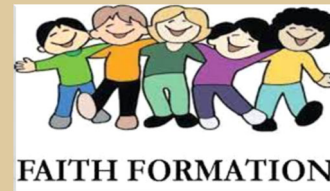

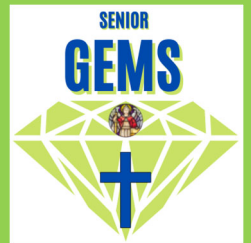

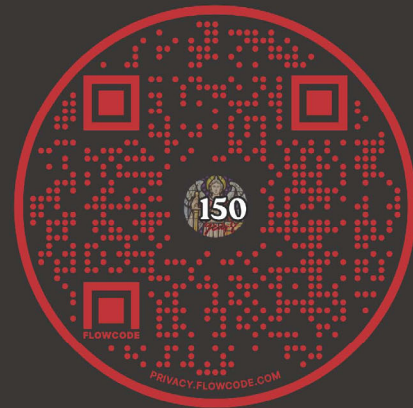

THE WORD

(Readings for June 11, 2023, The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ)

- I. *Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a* Moses reminded the people that for forty years God tested them in the desert. The Lord let them be hungry and fed them manna, showing God's people do not live by bread alone.
