From the Pastor's Desk

Would you welcome a prophet? Prophets are people who tell it like it is. Prophets are not fortune tellers, predictors of the future or people found on pyschic.com. Rather, prophets make us look closely at the things in life, in the here and now, attitudes and actions we would rather not look at or dwell upon at all. So, it's no wonder people are leery to welcome a prophet with open

arms.

Notice what happens in the Gospel story of Jesus' return to His home town. At first, everyone is struck by the reputation Jesus brings and then they hear His words and are challenged. In order to deflect Jesus' challenging message, they begin to belittle Him by pointing out that a man of His family history cannot be taken seriously. By doing this, they choose not to be open to God's power Jesus brings and so they cannot receive any of the benefits from that power.

The same holds true for us today. There are prophets among us.

People come into our lives as gifts from God, but sometimes we see them as curses. The risen Christ is very present in our midst but how often do we disregard His Presence? In the Holy Mass, Christ presents Himself to us in the consecrated bread and wine, His very person. Yet, when this mystery is approached how often are we willing to realize that Christ intends to change us, to perfect us, in His way, not our way? How often do we

come to communion on our terms and not open ourselves to God's terms?

You and I can easily become like the people in Jesus' hometown. Complaining about the length of Mass, or about the music, or the temperature in church, or just about how "my" time is more precious than.... God does not come on our terms; He is not swayed by our limited and narrow perceptions. God invites us to be free from these chains that hold our spirit captive to the passing concerns of daily life. God can take care of us if we let Him.

First, you and I need to know that letting go and letting God in is more than just a clever slogan. Letting God work in us involves challenge, challenge that is intended to help us grow. Jesus challenges us to love, to care for those we hate, to stop being selfish, to comfort those who mourn, to feed the hungry, to stop judging others and to forgive those who harm us.

There are many people through the ages, and down to today who have challenged Christians in Jesus' name. Do we hear the cries of Mother Theresa or the words of our own Bishops who call us to life, not death? To listen to the challenges of Jesus and be moved by them to act, opens us to God's power which can do more good in us than we could ever imagine.

"A LOOK BACK IN TIME"

In 1900, the parish purchased a 20 x 24-foot section of the old public school building and moved it north of the cemetery. On September 16, 1900, the first St. Michael School opened with 42 students, all in the higher grades. The parish had 55 students at the start of the next school year in 1901, and in 1903, the parish school opened a second room to provide full-time classes to younger children. In 1908, two classrooms were added to the parish school. During this time period Fr. Berg celebrated 25 years of priesthood and the parish held its first Corpus Christi procession and 40 Hours devotion.






