From the Pastor's Desk

Proper Grounding. The story of Martha and Mary has always stirred some strong feelings in its listeners. Because many listeners of this gospel story are like Martha working hard for their families or perhaps caring for an elderly parent while other siblings do little to help. This “Martha gene” in such hearers of today’s Word resent being told that all their hard work is not as important as Mary’s just sitting around listening to the Lord. After all, if it wasn’t for the Marthas of this world dinner would never make it to the table.

In the tradition of the Church the story has often been presented as the difference between the monastic/contemplative vocation of prayer found in those who profess vows to the work of the Church and the active vocation of those vowed to the married state and the demands of family life. This is certainly a layer of interpretation placed upon the story. It even seems to be a justification for the monastic or contemplative life as opposed to the more active and consequently less holy life of those who are like Martha. This “traditional” interpretation can certainly limit our understanding of what Jesus is trying to tell us.



However, this incident is related to us in the gospels not to justify one vocation over another vocational choice. To reduce it to such a nice and neat interpretation is to remove it from the larger gospel narrative of which it is a part. We need to take this incident seriously at face value.

Attending to the details of hospitality is not wrong. It is not wrong to be concerned about the needs of one’s guests or to be the caregiver or to work hard for one’s family. But when the details of hospitality, the hectic schedule of care-giving and the demands of work become the central focus rather than the guest, the person cared for, or the individual family members then there is a problem. This is the problem that Jesus reveals in Martha’s busyness. We can become so busy with the details of living life, running the kids to and fro, caring for family members or friends and work, that we lose sight of the great guest who is constantly in our midst.

Jesus is not just a guest we come to visit on Sunday alone. Jesus is a constant guest who demands our attention. He longs for you and I to be with him in prayer every day. Because he wants us to trust in him. He wants us to allow him to show us that spending time with him is not going to result in chaos and undone tasks. Rather, keeping him as the central focus makes sense of all our busyness.

All of our work will come to nothing if we do not stop and listen to Jesus’ word. Taking time to listen to our beloved guest gives us the proper grounding to be able to take on the tasks of daily life. No grounding in the Lord allows our busyness to become our god.
