
# From the Pastor's Desk

**Ready?** The scout moto is "Be prepared!" Preparation saves both time and money, it also saves frustration and worry. If preparation is such a good thing to do, why don't we do more of it? Why does putting things off, procrastination, all too often pull us by the arm and lead us into dangerous territory?

In our human nature we have two particular ways of dealing with reality. We either accept it or we try to avoid it. You and I vacillate between these two approaches, to one degree or another, from day to day and year to year. Like most other life decisions, we tend to lean more heavily in one direction or the other. There

are those who learn how to plan, prepare, and embrace what must be done and there are those who treat each day as it was the first day they lived, or the last.

No planning, no preparation usually leads to limited results when it comes to growth and progress. It is not that preparing for tomorrow today solves all problems or even makes tomorrow remarkably easier. Rather, preparing today professes a needed hope in tomorrow and the days to follow. Perhaps a symptom of our pessimistic society is a rise in the inability of more people who seem either unwilling or unable to plan for their future.



forgiveness of others and daily prayer (communication with God). You and I need to seek to live a holy life free from pornography, excessive violence in games and entertainment, and the false abundance that all our "toys" and possessions promise.

Now this is not easy, but the effort is necessary. Indeed, the effort shows how much we believe that God will save us. Our effort may seem slow but it points us in the right direction. The effort prepares us for what God has prepared for all of us. St. Paul tells us that "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen." Faith is not a surety but an attitude that helps us to see our goal (to live forever in sure love with God) and to witness in this life glimmerings of this hitherto unseen promise.

Without the continued effort to "be prepared" we will not be able to see those glimmerings, our faith becomes weak and thus our hope falters. When this happens, we seek the Kingdom of God in the things of this world and so would be unable to be ready for the Lord's return as the gospel today relates. Better to develop the habit to accept the reality we live (that this life is preparation for the next) than to escape from it in the powerful amnesia of the self-centered life.

**HOLY DAY OF OBLGATION THIS WEEK!** This coming Friday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary. The importance of this particular feast day should not be underestimated. Its all about our true and glorious destination. In a world that demeans and denies God's goodness, you and I need these special reminders of where our heart should rest. You and I are obliged to take time to attend Mass whether the evening before or on the day itself. On Thursday, August 14 Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 PM. On Friday, August 15 Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 AM, 12 noon and 7:00 PM. See you there.



# **Eucharistic Adoration**

The best kind of friend is the one with whom you can spend time without having to say anything. You can just share the moment and enjoy each other's company, knowing your relationship is deeper than the spoken word. That kind of silent communication is what takes place between you and Jesus when you participate in Eucharistic Adoration.



The Cursillo Movement is introduced Diocese of Gary via a three-day weekend retreat called a "Cursillo de Christianidad" which means "short course in Christianity" in Spanish. This retreat includes daily prayer, daily Mass, and opportunities for Spiritual **CURSILLO** Direction and Reconciliation. During the Retreat, a team of religious and lay people present a series of talks which are then discussed in small groups allowing for the sharing of personal insights.
