

#### From the Pastor's Desk

#### Guardian Angels? Submitted by Fr. Robert Ross

Many of us were taught this prayer as children: Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here; ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen. How many of us pray this prayer as adults? Unfortunately, our belief or awareness of our guardian angel often gets discarded as one of those "childish things" unfit for adulthood, like the monster under the bed or flying reindeer. Is it too far-fetched to believe that we are each assigned an angelic minister to protect us from harm? What has the Church said?

Our belief in the existence of guardian angels comes primarily from the words of Jesus: "See that you do not despise one of these little ones; for I tell you that in heaven their angels always behold the face of my Father who is in heaven" (Matt 18:10). It has been the tradition of the Church that each human being, from the moment that their soul was created, was assigned to the watchful care of an angelic spirit. We do not share or recycle guardian angels. When God created your guardian angel, He had one mission for its existence: to get you to heaven. Your guardian angel assists you in several ways: by protecting you from unforeseen physical danger; by protecting you from spiritual attacks and temptations; by suggesting good thoughts and actions to you; by soothing your emotions and calming your mind; by bringing good memories to your consciousness; by inspiring your prayer. When you arrive in heaven, you'll get to see all the ways your guardian angel has helped you without your awareness!

There is also a tradition in the Church that <u>every nation</u>, <u>diocese</u>, <u>church</u>, <u>family and priest receive a special guardian angel</u> to guide and protect them in their mission to love and serve God (in addition to their regular guardian angel). For example, St. Faustina used to receive visions of the guardian angel standing outside each church building she passed on her way to visit family. Moreover, in Sacred Scripture, St. Michael is referred to as the "Guardian" or "Prince" of the nation of Israel. Some theologians think that <u>angels have a hand in governing and protecting every aspect of the material universe</u>, making the number of angels God created astoundingly great—more than a googleplex!

We have to be careful, though, since our guardian angels aren't really *ours*; we don't possess our guardian angels—they are our superiors and custodians. In consequence, we don't get to name our guardian angels, nor should we ask for their names. Calling someone by their first name implies a familiarity with them or authority over them, and when we show respect to someone, we often use a title, like doctor, officer, or judge. Therefore, we humble ourselves and show respect to our guardian angel when we refer to him under the title of "Guardian."

Furthermore, our guardian angels aren't like pets, nor do we command our guardian angel to attack the devil, like a Pokémon trainer tells Pikachu to use "thunderbolt." Rather, whenever we pray to our guardian angels, we humbly ask them to assist us, knowing that <u>our guardian angels ultimately respond to the authority of God, not of us</u>. If something is for our good, God will allow them to assist us, and they are happy to do so because they are fulfilling their mission and purpose in life. We must always remember that <u>our guardian angel is a powerful angelic warrior</u>, far more intelligent than we are, existing longer than we have been alive.

May we frequently remember and call upon these gentle and caring guardian spirits!

#### "A LOOK BACK IN TIME"



On April 14, 2006 (Good Friday), Fr. Marty blessed the refurbished Stations of the Cross surrounding Mount Calvary which were cast in bronze from the originals. The parish had 2,564 families. In 2007, the Diocese of Gary celebrated its 50th anniversary, and in 2008, Rev. Mick Kopil, a son of the parish, was ordained to the priesthood. That same year, the parish began a capital campaign which included removing the old church structure. On May 19, 2009, Fr. Marty celebrated 25 years of priesthood, and on September 27, Fr. Marty dedicated St. Patrick Hall. In 2011, the parish began a campaign to repair cemetery walkways by inviting parishioners to

purchase engraved pavers which will help form new walkways. In December, crews began demolishing the old church structure and the demolition was completed in January 2012. The parish had 2,766 families. Submitted by the 150th Anniversary Committee


