## From the Pastor's Desk

**God does not delay, He is patient.** St. Peter is clear about one thing in today's second reading; the Lord does not delay! Rather, "*with the Lord one day is like a thousand years and a thousand years like one day.*" God works towards our advantage always. So, you and I can be ready for that great day when the Lord does come. God does not delay. God is infinitely patient with us finite beings. Indeed, you and I must learn a hard lesson first.

The lesson we need to learn is that there is an enemy that wants us to go astray. There is one who is set against us and our true happiness. Satan does exist, not primarily some sort of Hollywood fashion, but in much more subtle and devious ways. He would rather have us skip any preparation regarding the coming of Christ and move deceptively to make us think that we can feast without actually getting ready.

He wants us to pin the label "enemy" on others around us; those immigrants, those Republicans, those Democrats, those young people, those old people or an estranged spouse or family member. By tempting us to name them enemy, we play right into his hand, for Satan is all about division. He has an arsenal of tactics. He wants us to accuse others, even ourselves. He wants you to get discouraged. He wants you to feel you're alone, and he will even flatter you to get you.

Satan does not want you to think that he is really already defeated, and that he is far weaker than God. He maneuvers us with lies and deceptions making us his prisoners. You and I would be without hope if Jesus had not claimed us for Himself. We have been washed clean of the ancient disobedience of our first parents.

Yet, all too often we forget this, and we allow Satan to capture us again and hold us in disobedience. What is the solution? How do we overcome this tragic slavery? First, we must realize in our hearts and in our actions that we cannot maintain our freedom without the one who gained it for us in the first place. You and I must always, daily, even hourly, turn to Jesus for His help. He is the only one who can free us.

One important way we break free of this slavery is through the Sacrament of Penance. In this encounter we are reminded of the reconciliation the Christ Child brought to this world. All too often, people think: "I can do this by myself; I don't need to go to confession." However, full reconciliation with those whom our actions, or lack of action, hurts comes to us through the Church, the sacrament of Christ's reconciliation in the present.

Confession is necessary for reconciliation with my fellow Christians. Without this dimension, we allow the devil to fool us into justifying our actions or inaction that affects others and ourselves.

Going to confession with a repentant heart really kicks Satan in the teeth. When we are really sorry, we allow God to grace us with His protection, to help us avoid the deceptions of the devil and to more readily seek out the truth of God's love. God strengthens us in our call to be faithful in following His Son, Jesus. We are given the grace to forgive others, to heal divisions in our family, to treat everyone as my neighbor, and to more readily see who our true enemy is, Satan.

There are many reasons people stay away from celebrating God's reconciliation in the Sacrament of Penance. Some reasons are embarrassment, fear, pride or even laziness. All of these are put into our heads by Satan. He wants to keep you from being freed. Give yourself a gift this year and hand the fear and embarrassment over to God. Set aside the pride that keeps you from His presence in this sacrament and wake up from your sleep for the time draws near. The priest is not a judge. He is an outward sign of the invisible reality of God's forgiveness.

Take note of the absolution prayer the priest says at the end of your confession:

*God the Father of mercies through the death and resurrection of His Son has reconciled the world to himself and poured out the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church, may God grant you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father and the So, and the Holy Spirit.*

This prayer summarizes the teaching of our Church on this matter. It is the ministry (the work) of the Church (that is everyone represented in the person of the priest) to make God's reconciliation visible in this world. God gives the pardon and the peace; and the priest, in the name of the Church (Christ's body on earth) absolves (that is pronounces this freedom from guilt) to the penitent.






