## Description of Terms

**Annual** – One payment by cash, check, or credit card for the entire school year's tuition on or before August 8<sup>th</sup>. A discount of \$200 will be given for all families (K-8) who use this option on or before August 8<sup>th</sup>.

**Semester** – Two payments by cash, check, or credit card for one-half the school year's tuition. The first payment is due on or before August 8<sup>th</sup>, the second payment is due on or before January 8<sup>th</sup>.

**Monthly** – Ten monthly payments by Electronic Funds Transfer. The payments will be taken on the eighth day of every month, beginning in August and ending in May. The monthly tuition amount can be electronically transferred from any savings, checking, or credit card account.

**\*\*** Active parishioners of neighboring parishes that do not have a parish school can request a grant from their parish to help offset the school tuition. By Diocesan policy, such parishes are expected to assist their active parishioners. A form, provided by St. Michael's, detailing the outside parish grant from the neighboring parish, must be signed by the Pastor of that parish and returned at time of registration. Such parishes can be billed monthly or quarterly. If the status of a parishioner of a neighboring parish changes during the school year, the family is responsible for the remainder of the outside parish grant.
