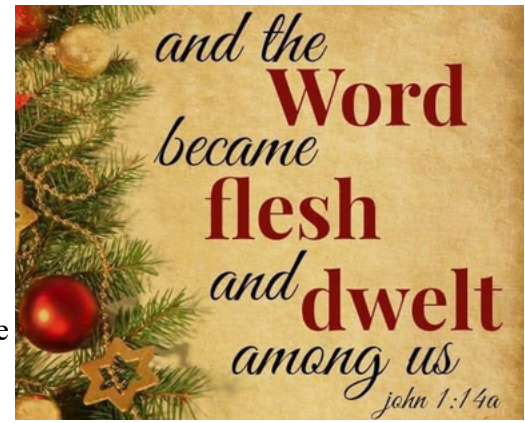

Do You Believe in the Real Miracle? As children, it always seemed that Christmas took forever to arrive. Yet, the wait added to the mystery of the season; it was and still is intoxicating. That mystery is exhibited in the bright lights that shine in the darkness, in the relatives seen once or twice a year, that to a child were all at once familiar but mysterious. Even, from a child's eyes, that strange man in a red suit that seemed jolly yet pretty ominous added to, and still does, the mystery. The incense that blesses the manger scene, and in the songs sung only yearly but remembered like they were sung everyday all provide a context that is familiar yet mysterious.



The older one becomes, the more the mystery starts to age and the more skeptical a person becomes about the man in the red suit and his reindeer. The familial relationships seem less mysterious and more fragmented. The bright lights bring worries about the NIPSCO bill. The sweet incense that blesses the union of God and humanity becomes a matter of division.

The very miracle of Christmas is this: God took on flesh with all its characteristics — the Creator took on the aspect of His creation, God became a human being. This is the miracle that is hard to accept. How often do we refer to the miracle of Christmas as angels singing or of animals talking or of the birth of a beautiful baby. Babies are indeed miracles but this baby is the highest of miracles. It is this miracle of God intervening directly into human history that King Ahaz in the first reading today politely refuses to believe, it is too much to ask of God, the king feels. Yet even if he is unwilling to believe this of God, God still acts, the prophet tells the king.

You and I sometimes find it nearly impossible to believe that God still directly intervenes in our daily life. We have grown leery of such promises as we age year after year. Yet, God still intervenes. God still comes to you and me daily and it is a miracle not unlike the miracle of His first coming in Bethlehem. The call this final week of Advent is to identify those attitudes I have adopted over the years that have made me skeptical about God's presence and work in my daily life. If I see God at work in the events and people I engage everyday, I will have no doubt that He dwells with me in my flesh because I dwell in His by baptism.

When you become more aware of God's daily presence in your life, its ups and downs, life does become a thanksgiving for this great gift of God's Presence. The world can take on that mystery it once held for us and once again we can gaze upon a manger scene with awe; realizing all the more as we grow from year to year the very audacity of God who loves us so much He sets aside His divinity to live in our humanity with the sole purpose of raising us up to live eternally with Him.

Getting Married? Start Your Married Life Off On the Right Foot. It is at this time of the year that many young people get engaged. Fr. Robert, Deacons Ron and Gary and I are charged with the responsibility to help couples prepare for the Sacrament of Marriage. If you or someone you know (another Catholic) is getting engaged, please remember that you need to contact the parish office no less than six months in advance.

A Catholic looking to get married must be married in a Catholic church witnessed by a Catholic priest or deacon. If one chooses not follow this expectation, the marriage is not sacramentally valid and thus the couple involved cannot go to communion. This is because, as Catholics, we believe that marriage is a sacramental state, not just a civil one.

Thus, it is best to contact the office sooner rather than later. This preparation is bolstered by other married couples in the parish and it takes time. We want to help you have a successful and happy marriage, not just a nice wedding day.

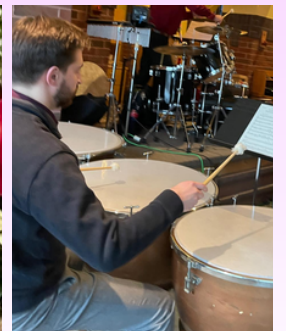

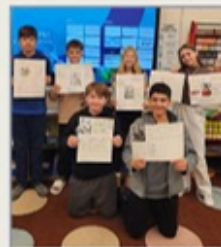

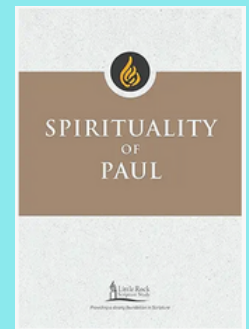
