

Sacrament of Penance...Saturday 3:30 PM-4:30 PM

Baptisms...First time parents at St. Michael must attend a Baptism Prep session before the baptism date can be scheduled. Please call Janice at ext. 8241 to schedule the prep session and/or baptism date.

Marriage....The bride, groom or their parents/grandparents must be active registered members of the parish for at least one year prior to reserving a date for the wedding. The diocese requires that arrangements must be made at least six months in advance of the wedding date in order for the proper personal, spiritual and liturgical preparations of the couple to be completed.

Sacrament of the Sick...Please call the office until 4:00 PM. After 4:00 PM, please call 322-6623 Monday-Friday and anytime on the weekend. Names of the sick are placed in the bulletin for a period of four weeks after which time they are either removed or placed in the Book of Intentions in the Chapel.

From the Pastor's Desk-

St. Michael the Archangel, Pray for Us! In the coming week or so you should receive our Parish Guidebook. This resource not only provides us contact information for fellow parishioners but also contains stories of the wonderful and varied works carried out by so many parishioners to bring God's love and compassion to those in our community. In addition, you will find our Parish Financial Statement. The stewardship of the treasure, shared with the parish, is reflected in the many ministries done for the building up of God's Kingdom.

Today, we celebrate God's blessings especially given through our patron saint, St. Michael the Archangel. Last year we celebrated 150 years of generosity and service by parishioners and benefactors. We had a grand time last year. This year I invite us all to reflect upon those events to see more keenly where Jesus is taking us in the years ahead. This is not always an easy task.

In our current culture the idea of a feast day is often tied up with a great deal of exterior activity, like last year's big Feast or Christmas, New Year's, Fourth of July, Memorial Day, All Saints Day and in particular its "hallowed eve" we call Halloween. All these days and many like them, the lesser feasts like individual birthdays, imply first and foremost activity.

When exterior activity is the main emphasis of the feast day we can easily tire of feasts. A balanced celebration of the feasts that the year brings around to us is needed for us to really appreciate our human need for feasting on certain days. The balance is found in the call for some reflection on our part. Advent precedes Christmas and Lent precedes Easter in order to provide a balance. All Souls Day follows from the feast of All Saints and Memorial Day begins with remembrances of those who have died for our freedom. So, either before or after you and I need time to reflect on the meaning of the feast we celebrate.

During our parish Feast Day celebration, you are invited to feast and to reflect. This is a day of thanksgiving for the many blessings God has given to our parish. The Ministry Faire is a cornucopia of the Holy Spirit's work among us; a celebration of our greatest gift, Baptism. The afternoon of Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament (12:45-4:00), is a time of reflection upon God's enduring Presence with us in the Holy Eucharist and how this Presence guides our daily lives, our families and our parish family. Our prayer together today reminds us through sights, smells, tasting and hearing of how special today is for us. Our eating together at God's table is reflected in our dining together in His presence at the Feast Day dinner on Sunday evening at 4:45 PM after Evening Prayer at 4 PM and Benediction.

Take time out on this, the Feast Day of our mighty patron, St. Michael the Archangel, to pray, reflect and celebrate. This helps us to celebrate God's grace given to us in the past, in the present and encourages us to trust that His grace will continue well into the future.

This Sunday, we heard from some of our parishioners about the good things happening here at St. Michael's. We also heard on how we need to embrace the economic realities of our "ora et labora", our prayer and work. Both are for the glory of God. Our monetary generosity is very much the thing that fuels our good work and prayer. It is not out of place for us to remind ourselves that our weekly offering needs to keep pace with the expenses we, as a parish, incur. As always, I know many of you will do your best. Thank you!


