## From the Pastor's Desk

**Easter Sunday** presents us with two possible scripture passages for the second reading. Though we will hear one or the other this Sunday, for it is the celebrant's choice, I think it is useful to understand their connection and what they tell us about who we are as newborn people in Christ.

One passage is from Paul's letter to the Colossians (3:1-2) and the other is from his first letter to the Corinthians (5:6b-8). The passage from Colossians urges us to realize that we have been "raised with Christ." So, we really need to be putting all our efforts and thoughts into "what is above and not what is on earth." Why? Because Christ is now "seated at the right hand of God" who is above. This necessity for us to aim for things above is not about a physical location, but about an attitude that does not allow itself to be bogged down with anxious concern, envy, pride, fear and distrust. These things, these attitudes, hold us to the earth, which is all about decay and loss. Rather, Paul wants you and I to understand that we have been recreated in baptism to be possessed by a vastly different attitude. An attitude of gratefulness, trust, generosity, forgiveness, and an acceptance of difficulties and sorrows with an eye to what endures, not to what decays and is lost.

Now for us to do this with greater zeal, Paul reminds us in the passage from Corinthians that we need to clear out the old attitudes. He likens those attitudes, bound to the earth, to be like yeast. A little goes a long way. A little envy produces more resentment, a little selfishness produces more self-pride, a little fear can balloon into anxiety and even loss of faith. That is why he says, "Clear out the old yeast so that you may become a fresh batch of dough inasmuch as you are unleavened."

Paul's analogy can lead us to a deeper understanding of who we now are in Jesus. The analogy of unleavened dough should not be lost on us. This is the bread of the new promise, the Bread of Life, not death and its accompanying attitudes mentioned. Just as we partake of the New Bread of Life we are given the grace to become like Christ in all our dealings. We can become bread for the life of the world through Jesus. By clearing out the old yeast of sin and malice in our daily lives, Jesus transforms us into people of light and hope and all the good things that follow.

If you and I don't take seriously the need to cast out all the old yeast, Easter Sunday will be just another day of the family gathering for a "celebration" that passes into some photos and memories that can fade. Continue to allow Jesus to help you to rid yourself of the old yeast (attitudes) that keeps you bound to the earth and prevents you from seeking what is above.

This day reminds us that this work that Paul calls us to is ultimately accomplished by our trust in the Lord Jesus, who risen from the dead, can carry us with Him to what is above even as we are still on this earth. Let generosity direct your thoughts, allow kindness to be the light for your path, pursue what is right and just in God's eyes, not the world's. Fear nothing, envy nothing, let anxiety flee. You or I cannot know our blessed destiny if we harbor some yeast. Rather, become what you receive in Holy Communion, the Living Bread for the life of the world, the "bread of sincerity and truth."

This is why the being a Catholic Christian is not belonging to a club or a support group, it is belonging to Christ. This belonging is not satisfied in an occasional recognition of membership. This belonging is an every day, every hour journey with Jesus for you and me to be fully changed, converted and transformed into a new man/woman. The new man/woman remade in the image of the Son, the image of Love.

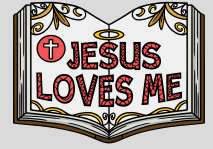
