**Graduation Reflections.** A few weeks ago, we celebrated the 125<sup>th</sup> graduating class from St. Michael Parish School. On that occasion I invited the graduates and those there to witness the occasion to reflect briefly on why St. Michael parish and school is still important today. In that same spirit, we reflect on why the Church, the Roman Catholic Church to which we belong, continues to be relevant. I understand many do not think the Church is relevant. However, events surrounding the recent Papal Encyclical point to the true reality of why the world in which we live needs the Church. A recent article I read about the encyclical put all the press attention in its proper place. This is what I shared with those at graduation.

“Those who graduated in that first class of 1901 had no idea of the ups and downs that would follow in their lives. Two World Wars, the Great Depression, the rise of the automobile and communication technologies, and even putting a human being on the moon was not in their scope of vision. All of these seemed distant to them at that time, some even unimaginable. Thus, it has been with later generations of graduates. This is a truth that holds for this year’s graduates as well.

As we commemorate the 125 years of our parish school’s existence and the Catholic centered education and formation it provides, it is a good thing to reflect on our past because without it there can be no secure future. Indeed, without the treasures of the Church, of which you have only begun to know, our future will end in disarray like those who were building that tower in Babylon.

Pope Leo’s first pastoral letter to us all is entitled, “Magnificent Humanity.” The first words of the encyclical set the tone for his teaching. Humanity is what is God’s magnificent creation, the things we create, including AI, is only as good and noble as we are created to be.

At the presentation of his Encyclical a Canadian AI developer, Christopher Olah was there. This raised eyebrows; was the Vatican in league with AI development? The real reason is far more encouraging. He leads a company intimately involved in this AI quest, particularly what is called “interpretability research” which is the effort to understand what happens inside AI models. He is not a diplomat or a philosopher. He builds things. He spoke as a builder, asking for help from those outside the construction site. He said, that every frontier AI lab, including his own, operates under pressures that can conflict with doing the right thing: commercial pressure, geopolitical pressure, and the oldest pressures of pride and ambition. He was seeking a solid external voice that could counter those pressures mentioned. He came to the Church.

He sees the Church as a necessary counterweight. AI is unlike other things we build, like bridges, cars or computers, where we know how the parts work. AI is different, Olah describes it as structures grown (not built) on a scaffold, modeled after the human brain, fed by our heritage of thought and language (the good and the bad). They are made up of us, and they remain mysterious even to those who train them. He realizes that the question of AI is not *a technical question with ethical consequences but a spiritual question with technical implications.*

Olah is concerned about three things:

1. The poor: about the risk that AI displaces work at vast scale, while the benefits of AI stay concentrated in wealthy nations, the poor get poorer and the rich get richer.
2. Human flourishing: what does it mean to live fully in a world pervaded by generative models — AI as something we no longer use, like in our Google search, but inhabit on a daily basis.
3. And regarding the nature of the AI models themselves: he says he continually finds “mysterious things” within them and knows they require ongoing discernment.

Here, the Church’s voice becomes necessary, not because theology has ready answers on artificial consciousness, but because it possesses thousands of years of tradition of discerning spirits distinguishing what is authentic from what merely simulates authenticity. Distinguishing between what is real, from what feigns to be real or artificial. The Church is called not to bless or condemn the industry, but to think about the human person at the precise moment when the boundaries of the human person are being redrawn.

That is WHY we are still here. This Church of which you are a part is essential in keeping you, indeed all of us, in our real condition as God’s **magnificent humanity**. It is our faith rooted in the Creator Himself, and in the knowledge that God loved us so much that He entered into our human reality as one like you and me. He lived through the ups and downs never forgetting who He was, God’s beloved and He gave us that same confidence never to forget we are His beloved. Never discount the great gift you have in Christ and His Church.

The generations before you flourished and gave you what you have so you can flourish. They flourished because they remained faithful to the one reality that never changes. That true reality that acts as the stable platform from which the ‘spirit of the age’ can be judged. What is real and what is artificial. You will need that stable platform in your years ahead and you will need to make it stronger. Make it stronger with regular prayer, the weekly celebration of Mass, and always in generosity to others and good works. Then one day you might be sitting out there watching the 150<sup>th</sup> graduating class of St. Michael School.

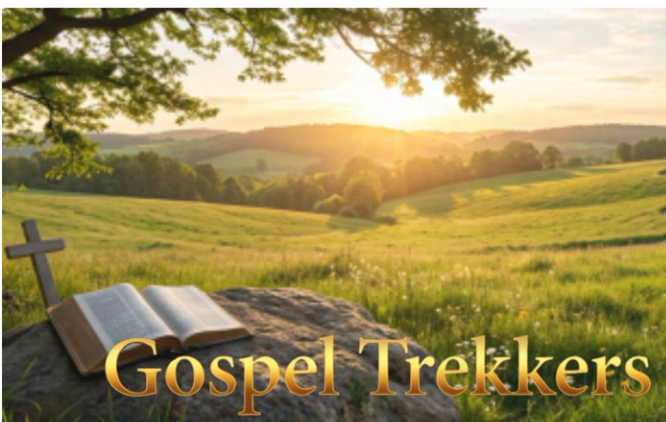
