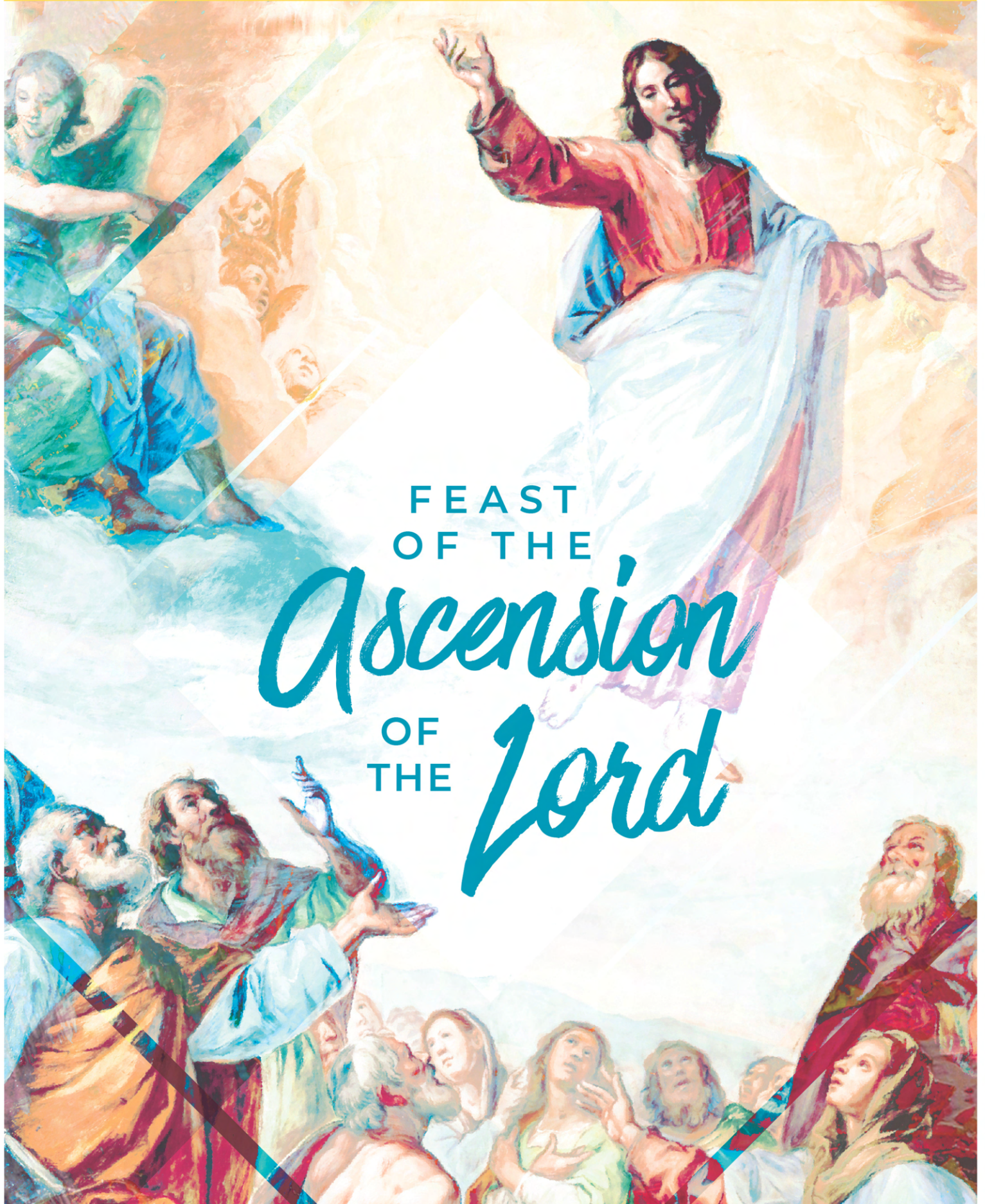

Baptisms...First time parents at St. Michael must attend a Baptism Prep session before the baptism date can be scheduled. Please call Janice at ext. 8241 to schedule the prep session and/or baptism date.

Marriage....The bride, groom or their parents/grandparents must be active registered members of the parish for at least one year prior to reserving a date for the wedding. The diocese requires that arrangements must be made at least six months in advance of the wedding date in order for the proper personal, spiritual and liturgical preparations of the couple to be completed.

From the Pastor's Desk

The Wear'n of the Red. Today we commemorate the fortieth day of Easter by remembering the Ascension of our Lord. Yet, Jesus promises the apostles that he will not leave them alone, abandoned. He will send to them the Advocate, the Holy Spirit. The One who will enlighten them further and always be there for them, the Advocate. So, during this week we wait.


We are not always very good at waiting; but wait we must. We can take our cue from the disciples gathered in the upper room waiting for Jesus' promise to come true. Waiting is truly an art. Waiting is not time lost, rather it is precious time gained. It is time to think and pray, time to know what you need in order to do what God asks of you.

We wait upon the Holy Spirit this week not just for ourselves but for us as a whole people, as the Church. If you have not begun the Pentecost Novena (9 days of prayer) this past Thursday you can begin today. It is made available to everyone who signed up for our Flocknote. Some hard copies are available in the Gathering Space. Make it part of your daily prayer, in the morning or at night before you retire or at the dinner table with the family. Spend some time this week waiting on the Holy Spirit.

We often take the work of the Holy Spirit for granted. Sometimes it's helpful to consider what we would not have if we didn't have the Holy Spirit, our Advocate. In your prayer, imagine what it would be like if the Holy Spirit did not dwell in your heart. Imagine what it would be like not to be able to forgive. Imagine what it would be like not to be able to be generous with your love. Imagine what it would be like not to be able to know that God loves you so very much. Imagine what it would be like not to have the wonderful feeling that comes from being generous. Life without the Holy Spirit would be very different. Without the Holy Spirit you and I would not have to care about anyone, we would be wrapped up in our own self. Absolute self-gratification would be our mode of operation. This sounds attractive; indeed, it is what the world sells us, but it is a very lonely place to be.

The Holy Spirit opens us up. Maybe that is why red is the Spirit's color. Red is a brazen color, a color that is loud and bawdy. Red is warm and inviting. The fire of the Holy Spirit is meant to burn away all that is selfish in me and you. It is given to us, this fire, for us to tend and stoke into a burning love for God and so for others. In this way the red fire of the Spirit, implanted in our hearts is also brash and bold. It sends us out to make a statement about God's burning love for all our community, for all the world. That is why it can be said for me and you that red is our color. Whatever you might think about its fashion statement, it is for us a Faith statement. You and I are red people. We cannot hide our redness; we cannot hide the Spirit that is alive in our hearts. Celebrate your redness. Join me and **wear red next weekend.**

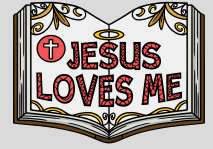
