**God does things God's way.** The unions would have not been pleased with God's labor relations as portrayed in today's Gospel story. Indeed, I have often heard people comment that this story about God's generosity is hard to take. I have always been curious about this strong reaction to the vineyard owner who decides to pay everyone the same wage despite the number of hours they worked. In the story, there is no injustice done. Those who came to work the first thing in the morning were paid what they expected for a day's work.

Objections can only arise if we think that God's mercy depends upon what we do to earn it. The point of the story is clear; God's mercy is equal for everyone. In other words, mercy is mercy. We can't earn more mercy, either one is forgiven or one is not forgiven. This of course is unsettling if we are the kind of person who likes to think we know what God is thinking. And if God is not thinking what we think God should think, well then, we have some advice for God.

There is another way to look at this story that could help us to see the benefit of having such a generous God. Perhaps we should not be so ready to consider ourselves as the workers who have been hard at it all day. Who's to say, for all we know we might be the ones who need mercy in the final hours of the day. It is true that we should never presume on the mercy of God, but it is also true that we should never be overconfident about our already enjoying God's mercy. Actually, the picture of God painted in today's Gospel is rather consoling when we realize that we might be the last ones in the vineyard.

**As we celebrate our patron's feast, St. Michael the Archangel, it is fitting for us to spend some time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament of our Lord's Body in Eucharistic Adoration. 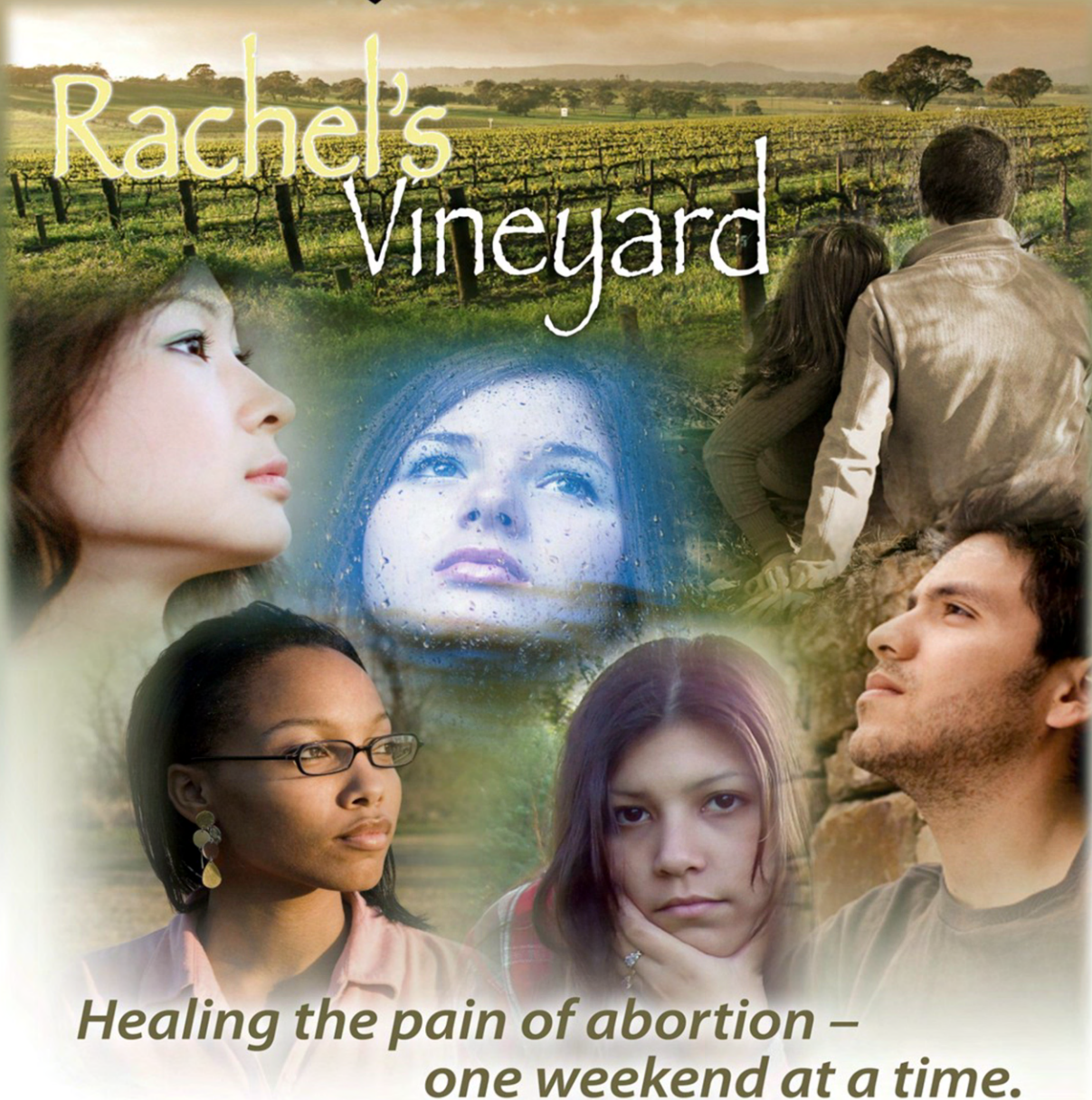
