Baptisms...First time parents at St. Michael must attend a Baptism Prep session before the baptism date can be scheduled. Please call Janice at ext. 8241 to schedule the prep session and/or baptism date.

Marriage....The bride, groom or their parents/grandparents must be active registered members of the parish for at least one year prior to reserving a date for the wedding. The diocese requires that arrangements must be made at least six months in advance of the wedding date in order for the proper personal, spiritual and liturgical preparations of the couple to be completed.

From the Pastor's Desk

Alleluia, He is Risen!! Dressing up for Easter Sunday still seems to be in fashion. Sometimes it means buying new clothes. Dressing in new clothes carries with it a particular feeling. A feeling of newness, freshness and even hope. Our Easter finest is a bold reminder to us of the TRUE Easter clothes with which we have been dressed.

When we came up from the Baptismal Font, we were dressed in white garments, our baptismal dress. This white garment was commended to you and me, and our parents and godparents, to be kept free from the stain of sin because it is the wedding garment each of us will wear into the great Wedding Feast of Heaven. But we know we have allowed it be stained.

We have spent the last several weeks realizing our need to seek God's mercy so our white garment can once again be gleaming with the joy and promise of the Resurrection. So great is God's mercy that even if we waited till the very end of our Lenten preparation to seek his mercy in acts of prayer, penance and almsgiving, God still makes us shimmer with the original whiteness of our baptismal dress.

It is this mercy that has made ready for us a place at God's Heavenly Wedding Feast. We have to be ready for what God has made ready for us. Complacency needs to be burnt up by the fire of the Holy Spirit. Fear needs to be quelled by Jesus' comfort. Action needs to be embraced in receiving the sacraments of our salvation free from sin which hinders their effect.

Easter is not the end but the beginning. If I hope to partake of the purpose of Easter, I need to let go of laziness, stubbornness, self-indulgence, resentment, judgementalism; in short, all those attitudes that allow me to put away my Easter finest in the closet till next year.

It is not wise for me to waste the power of what God has done for me; what God has done for you, for all of us. I need to act everyday out of the power of what God has done. When I open myself to this, I cannot allow my Easter finest to be packed away, I need to wear it in preparing for the Wedding Feast by joining in the practice for that day. That practice happens at the Feast of His Table on earth, each Sunday.

The Altar of Christ beckons you and me to be near it, to be fed with His Word and Body each week. In this, you and I can find preparation for the greater banquet of Life Eternal.

The Growing into the Future (GIFT) Campaign has great news to share!

Great News! Your generous pledges and dedication to our Growing Into the Future Together campaign have made it possible to begin the air conditioning of the school building, our first goal.

- The construction work will begin on June 7 and is expected to be completed by August 1. Our general contractor, Larson Danielson, has assured us that the construction schedule is sufficient to complete the project within the allocated time.
- All air conditioning units will be installed on the roof to prevent damage and theft of the equipment. Each unit serves a single classroom, meaning that if one unit encounters a problem, only that classroom will be affected. Each classroom will draw in fresh air from outside for heating and ventilation, incorporating a filtration system to keep dust and particles out of the room. This setup will help reduce allergy issues, among other benefits. Additionally, measures have been taken to ensure a balanced temperature between the sunny classrooms on the south side of the building and the shaded classrooms on the north side.
- The GIFT campaign's second goal is to build a new handicapped-accessible Parish Administration Building that is safe for all volunteers, visitors, and staff. Since February, contributions for this project have been increasing as planned. Your continued support is vital to keep us on track. Thank you for your pledge and commitment.
- Finally, there is a special opportunity involved in this second goal. Fr. Connolly, the beloved pastor of this parish responsible for our beautiful church building, once commissioned stained glass windows for the now-closed St. Catherine of Siena Parish in Hammond. St. Michael's acquired those windows before the property was sold. The goal is to reinstall these custom-made stained-glass windows in the new construction to preserve Fr. Connolly's legacy. 
