

#### From the Pastor's Desk

What really is NEW? One law of successful marketing is to present the consumer with a new product. In truth, most things presented as "new" on the market are really old. Either they are old products that are improved and repackaged or they are old ideas that are for the first time mass produced and then marketed. Creating something totally new, that is, making something out of nothing, is only possible for God.

If re-invented and repackaged products touted as "new" are so attractive to you and me, how much more attractive would be the promise of something really totally new? That is what we are promised as God's people. All the revelations that John recorded in his book find their climax not in the destruction, in hell fire and brimstone, but in a new creation. God's creative energy is revealed to John in a vision and this vision was not of the distant future. John wanted the early Church to be assured that, despite the persecutions they suffered, God's new creation is already overtaking the old world. God's triumph has already begun and the followers of Jesus who are the primary instruments of God's creative energy, are bringing the "new" to light.

We are the new creation. We live in the fulfillment of the revelations John recorded in his book. The destruction of the old world has already taken place in Jesus' death and resurrection. You and I, his followers, now become God's hands and feet, God's eyes, ears, and voice. The really totally new creation is made first in you and me. This newness then spreads into our relationships, at home and at work and in school. Through this progression, God makes the whole world new.

This is not as dramatic as Hollywood would present the destruction of the old and the creation of the new. But our lives are really quite dramatic as you and I struggle to grow beyond our "old self" of sin and selfishness into a "new person" of compassion and selflessness.

FIRST COMMUNICANTS are especially invited to dress in the First Communion clothes to help lead the procession. All of our prayerful labors

are rewarded in the end with a wonderful lunch provided for all the "pilgrims" who walked with Jesus. Whoever said, "religion isn't fun" has never been to one of these festive gatherings.


