**Marriage...**The bride, groom or their parents/grandparents must be active registered members of the parish for at least one year prior to reserving a date for the wedding. The diocese requires that arrangements must be made at least six months in advance of the wedding date in order for the proper personal, spiritual and liturgical preparations of the couple to be completed.

## From the Pastor's Desk

---

**Family Ties.** We have many connections because of our families, a lot of family ties. Although we probably wouldn't mind breaking a few, we find that family ties are very strong. Like a pit bull, once they get a grip on you they are hard to shake loose.

Most of our family ties are worth keeping. Healthy family ties bind people into a family without restricting the family members. Some of those healthy ties are trust, sacrifice and care. Trust is a necessary family tie. It's opposite, suspicion, can cripple and divide a family. Trust heals. The more families learn to trust one another the more they allow their members to take good risks and allow them to grow. Trusting is also acting like God acts. After all, God trusted a human family enough to enter into one and be raised by one in the person of Jesus.

Sacrifice is another value needed for strong family ties. Sometimes sacrifice is the only glue that can hold a family together. For us today, a sacrifice is to strive to live a simple lifestyle, not putting a lot of stock in possessions. A bigger TV set, a new car or more money in the paycheck does not tie a family together. Sacrificing these things to spend more time with the children and with one's spouse is what ties a family together.

Care too, is a value that ties family members one to another. Care in a family means putting people first, not myself. A family that cares for each other doesn't worry about whether the family members deserve their care. Care is what endures in a family. It is the quality that leads to reconciliation after an argument.

These qualities don't bind people into a perfect family but into a compassionate family. Lived well, these values don't constrict a family to only be concerned about itself but leads the family to share these very values with others, with strangers who become friends and family extended. Great families learn from each member in the family and invite others into their circle. Such was the case with the Holy Family which made all families one.

**Thank You!** Thank you for all the many Christmas greetings and gifts. I thank God for your faithfulness to this parish and to His work.

**Marriage Preparation.** It is at this time of the year and in the month ahead that many young people get engaged. If you or someone (another Catholic) is getting engaged, please remember that you need to contact the parish office no less than six months in advance.

A Catholic looking to get married must be married in a Catholic church witnessed by a Catholic priest or deacon. Any dispensation from the "form" must be approved by the Bishop. If one chooses not to follow this expectation the marriage is not sacramentally valid and thus the couple involved cannot go to communion. As Catholics, we believe that marriage is a sacramental state, not just a civil one.

Fr. Jacob, Deacon Ron and I are charged with the responsibility to help couples prepare for the Sacrament of Marriage. Thus, it is best to contact the office sooner rather than later. The preparation period is at least six months, so it is best to contact us nine months from the wedding date. This preparation is bolstered by other married couples in the parish and it takes time. Time that cannot be made up. The whole of six months is needed. We want to help you have a successful and happy marriage, not just a nice wedding day.



## All Are Welcome to Attend Alpha!

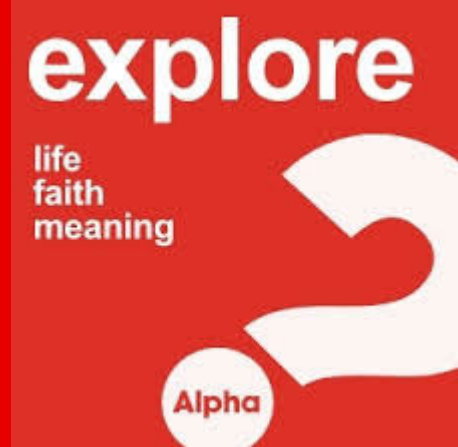
**St. Michael's ALPHA Kick-Off Party is January 27th, 7:00-9:00 PM, in St. Patrick Hall.**

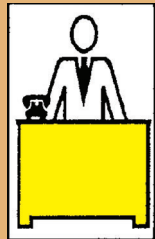
