### A LETTER FROM FR. MARTY

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ.

I have, for many years, longed to present to you a fuller report of our stewardship. That is, to present for everyone's understanding the breath and depth of Christian generosity and service that this parish community undertakes. Our financial heath and generosity is only the tip of the iceberg. But, for all too long we have not appropriately celebrated the many ministries and activities that strive to bring the love of Christ to our parish and the larger community, we are called to serve in Christ's name.

It is important to know the numbers (SS) but the numbers do not proclaim the message. We need to remind ourselves of the values that lie behind the numbers. When we do this, we are reminded why we exist. We exist to use our gifts and talents to bring Christ to others; to our young children, our youth, our aged parishioners and to those who are less fortunate.

Because this report covers the fiscal year of June 2021 to June 2022 there is no mention (other than some pictures) of the extensive work done in the church building in response to the smoke event of January 2021. Suffice to say that nearly all that work and the expenses associated with vacating the church to have Mass in the gym was covered by our building insurance. Any expenditures regarding this work have fallen into the present fiscal year thus, they will be covered in the 2023 report.

This Annual Report of Our Stewardship is the first attempt to present that fuller picture of the faithful generosity of parishioners. Such a report as this measures the impact that our parish makes in people's lives; it focuses us on the mission of the Gospel. It is not merely a description of activities undertaken by us as a parish either, but it provides an analysis on the results of these activities. Such a report begins to help us to review our ministries and activities in relation to our Parish Mission and Pastoral Plan.It helps us to work at improving our outreach and it both builds up our joy at what has been done in Christ's name and it enkindles a longing to be even more loyal disciples. A report such as this also furthers our knowledge of what the parish is doing and it celebrates the many faithful lay ministers and volunteers who make it happen as it invites others to join in the good work of St. Michael's.

Not everything is included in this first expanded report of stewardship. There are so many fantastic stories that have yet to be told. Stories of success of our grade school students and our graduates. Stories of faith developing with our young people in Faith Formation and the School and stories of service from so many other ministries that you support with your prayers, time and generosity. I hope, in the years to come, to expand this report even more fully.

When the disciples returned from their first missionary journey Jesus called them together and said: "Come away and rest a while." This Report of Our Stewardship is a little respite for all of us to smile at what has been accomplished for the glory of God and to recharge ourselves to forge ahead in faith, hope and charity as Missionary Disciples.

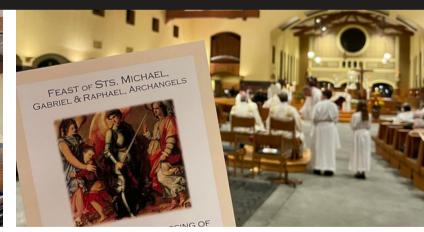
