

## From the Pastor's Desk

God's Seating Plan. Several years ago I celebrated the sacrament of Marriage with a couple of eastern European (Balkan) decent. In our last meeting as we were planning the details of the wedding Mass I asked the couple if I would be sitting at the reception with one of their parents. They responded by telling me that I would be sitting at the head table. Usually, this means being relegated to the far end of the table next to the ring bearer. However, they told me that I would be sitting next to them. I insisted that sitting with the bride of groom's parents was gracious enough. But they insisted that that not only do I sit next to me, but actually between them.

No, that seemed just not right. But they informed me that in their cultural experience the priest sat at the head table in the middle. Needless to say I felt embarrassed by this possibility. But, they insisted that the priest is there not because of who he is personally to them but because he is symbolically the presence of Christ, like at the wedding feast at Cana. Then the bride quickly added that besides that, they both enjoyed my company. I was still reticent that this was not the usual seating arrangement. I even mentioned it to the parents at the rehearsal, but they too were insistent.

The evening turned out better than I expected. It was really a fun celebration. What happened when everyone rang their glasses? Well, I would lean back and the bride and groom would give each other a kiss. As I read the gospel story about not seeking the higher place, I thought about this incident. Actually, I was trying to secure my "comfortable" place setting with the parents who I knew, but other plans humbled me. It was not me who was honored, but the priesthood that I have been gifted with. It was, I reflect upon it, a humbling experience.

We often want to place ourselves in the most comfortable spot at a dinner party or even in life itself. But God most often has other plans for us. He might raise us up (in the eyes of others) or seat us lower. Whether we are at the head table or not is not the issue rather it is whether we can allow God to seat us where he wants us to be seated. Often times we have a difficult time going where God wants us to go. Perhaps we would rather be unnoticed, but God wants you to be a servant for Him, maybe to serve His Body and Blood or to serve up His sacred Word, reading to others. Maybe we want to be in charge, but God wants us to share our talents and not dominate with them.

I did not want to sit at the head table with the bride on my right and the groom on my left. This was not where I wanted to be. But it is where God put me that night. I was humbled by that experience, but also God taught me a lesson about the gift of the priesthood he has given me. I think each of us have had a similar experience, when we are put in places we would rather not be. God has a way of making each place we find ourselves, if we trust in him, the exact place we need to be to receive a surprising gift from God.

*Our Feast Day, 151 Years Strong.* On the last Sunday of September, September 28, we will celebrate our parish feast day. The Solemnity of St. Michael the Archangel. Last year our day was marked by a glorious celebration on Mt. Calvary with the Bishop, several Priests of the Diocese, Religious Sisters and over 700 people.

This year we give thanks by celebrating our commission to serve as Christ serves us. There will be donuts and fellowship after Sunday Masses. ALSO, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament throughout the afternoon that day and conclude with Benediction and Evening Prayer at 4:00 PM. That will be followed by our customary Feast Day Dinner, yum, yummm. Mark your calendar and come and celebrate.


