***The Art of God.*** Falsely and often, the argument has been put forth that the God of the Old Testament was a vengeful god. That the God we see depicted there was a jealous and hard god. This theory or reading of the Old Testament is derived principally from the books surrounding the forty years the Chosen People journey in the desert and their conquest of the land of “milk and honey” God promised them through Moses. But the vast majority of the Old Testament reveals a God far more intimate and caring, indeed even loving.

In the first reading today from Deuteronomy, a book often and sadly portrayed as a “rule book,” we hear about the God of all creation choosing to take a people, a portion of His creation, to Himself to reveal His Presence to the nations. This is why it was, and still is, important to God that His people, whether that people be people of the First Covenant or you and I, the chosen of the New Covenant in Christ, be kept clear of that which would lead them astray. This concern is borne out of the fact that God has chosen to reveal Himself through His creation, you and me. God continues to make this choice as it is firmly and permanently ratified in Jesus, the Son of God made one with us in the flesh.

In Christ, the Father made the deepest intention of His love for all of humanity known – He gave His very self in His only-begotten Son to live among us, to bring us His eternal healing and forgiveness and to show us how to love – to love to the end, a love that gives fully. Christ in turn is often given exclusive coverage when it comes to Christianity, especially Catholic Christians. This is understandable considering this ultimate intimacy, the mystery of God becoming man, dying for us to relieve us of our primordial disobedience first enacted by Adam and Eve. Then too, rising to New life. His obedience to the Father justifies us and releases us from the debt of sin and death to become sharers in His Eternal Destiny.

But, Jesus, both before His death and after His resurrection is very clear that the fullness of what God began with the Chosen People and brought to fulfillment in the flesh through Him would not be complete until the Holy Spirit could be sent forth from Him and the Father to bring us all into unity with our God. The Holy Spirit is the Guide for us today. The Spirit enables us to understand clearly what Jesus not only instructed us but, by his very suffering and death, showed us as the road to our true destiny.

You see, to lump God into three different manifestations that have little to do with each other is not to truly see God in all of God's Presence. This mystery of the Triune God is far more a work of eternal art than something you and I are going to “figure out.” What we need to realize in our daily life is the presence of our God, Father and Son and Holy Spirit in all the ways we are called to imitate God's creative and caring love and Christ's redemptive love that gives even when and especially when it is difficult. We are supported in this by giving thanks for the abiding love of the Holy Spirit that helps us to know when we are in line with the Father's Will for us and are truly living the selfless love of Jesus in how we treat each other.

Next Sunday, Sunday, June 7th we will celebrate the Feast of the Corpus Christi. At the end of the 11:30 AM Mass we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament in honor of our Lord and Savior. Along the route we will have altars set-up to pause for prayer and song and special blessings (Benedictions) given with the Blessed Sacrament. FIRST COMMUNICANTS are especially invited to dress in the First Communion clothes to help lead the procession. All our prayerful labors are rewarded in the end with a wonderful lunch provided for all the “pilgrims” who walked with Jesus. Whoever said, “religion isn't fun” has never been to one of these festive gatherings.

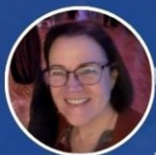

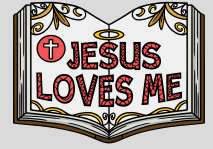
