The diocese requires that arrangements must be made at least six months in advance of the wedding date in order for the proper personal, spiritual and liturgical preparations of the couple to be completed.

From the Pastor's Desk —

Surprise, surprise! The quest of modern society, especially in the past 100 years, has been to make daily life more secure and less surprising. So comfortable have we become with security that we are shocked to hear of viruses that seemingly have no cure or tainted hamburger patties at our favorite fast food chain. Though these surprises are unwelcome they do remind us that life is never certain. Being nervous about surprises is good and bad. In one respect it encourages us to plan so we are not caught in a tight spot. On the other hand, it can encourage us to close ourselves off from new experiences and new people. This kind of security is really a prison. Avoiding surprises in our prayer, public or private, is not a virtue.

Today's feast of the Epiphany is all about surprises and the goodness of surprises. The surprise is that God has come into the world not just for the chosen people but for all people, even people who don't believe in God. Now, this might not come to us as a shocking revelation, but it was to the people of the first century. It could be a revelation for us to realize that God breaks through to you and me in similar surprising ways. The person(s) with whom we have a problem - surprise! - they can easily be God's challenge to us to grow and perhaps look at the world in a different way. The frustrations at work or in school - surprise! - can be God's way of waking us up to new possibilities. Difficulties in a relationship with someone we care for - surprise! - can easily be God's invitation to seek God's wisdom through a counselor or spiritual director.

If we have the notion that surprises are to be avoided, then we limit ourselves to experiencing God in our lives. Remember, our God is full of surprises. This is the God who made a virgin the mother of God, this is a God who surprised Elizabeth, the God who surprised the leaders of the people in sending John the Baptist, the God who surprised all of history by first becoming a human being and then freely giving his life so all of us might live for him, forever. If we expect God to act, be ready for a surprise.

Hello, my name is Nickolas Melendez. I've been a student at St. Michael's School since preschool with Mrs. Ellen. I completed two years of preschool, and now I am in eighth grade. The teachers are truly amazing and love to share all of their personalities. You will get to know them as someone to trust and look forward to being with them. The teachers really do love and care for you as if you were their own. They will give you attention to listen to any problems you may have. They will comfort you and help anyway they possibly can. My math teacher has saved me so many times from forgetting homework and leaving my Chromebook.

As I leave St Michael's School after this year, I am searching for a good high school. I have some good options, and I think it's between Bishop Noll or Andrean. I think both are very good schools.
